Position Title: DSM Program Manager

Company Description: ICAST (International Center for Appropriate & Sustainable Technology) is a local non-profit organization working to address climate change and affordable housing issues by installing clean energy solutions in multifamily housing. Our projects foster economic viability, environmental stewardship, and social responsibility in under-served communities in Colorado, New Mexico, and Texas. Our vision is to scale nationally.

Position Overview: This position has been created to manage ICAST's expansion into Utah and grow its current business in New Mexico for the Demand Side Management (DSM) programs with utilities. This position will be located in SLC, Utah.

The primary emphasis for this role is:

- Establish and manage a new DSM program with local Utility in Utah.
- Manage existing DSM program with local utility in New Mexico (NMGC)
- Develop opportunities with other utilities regionally to establish new DSM programs for multifamily (MF) properties.

Duties will include managing relationships with utility companies, state officials, MF property owners, and other stakeholders involved in developing and managing DSM programs, plus helping ICAST staff with other duties and projects as necessary. This position will also support ICAST efforts to provide MF customers with consulting services for modeling energy savings, obtaining green building certifications, conducting Green Physical Needs Assessments, preparing utility allowance analysis, overseeing energy efficiency upgrades and conducting M&V for MF properties.

It is important for the DSM Manager to keep up with technology and other innovations in the DSM space so as to provide appropriate advice to ICAST and its Utility clients on optimal solutions and process improvements that improve the DSM program.

Position Duties:

1. Responsible for the success of the ICAST multifamily DSM program
2. Relationship management with utility, MF property owners, and other stakeholders
3. Coordination with utilities and MF owners for requests for energy data, rebates, and other requests
4. Establish and manage the Utah MF DSM program and oversee the NM MF DSM program
5. Develop new opportunities with other utilities for MF DSM programs for ICAST
