Position Title: Solar Program Manager

Company Description:

ICAST (International Center for Appropriate & Sustainable Technology) is a national non-profit organization working to address affordable housing, climate change and community development issues using clean, energy solutions. ICAST is focused on upgrading the efficiency of multifamily affordable housing.

Position Overview:

ICAST is embarking on an innovative program to create better access to solar energy for tenants of low income multifamily affordable properties (MFAH). ICAST is seeking a candidate with solar development experience to manage this program. Primary functions of this position include developing PV solar and solar/storage projects for low income multifamily properties, through outreach and relationship building with stakeholders such as owners, investors and utilities and financial institutions.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Outreach to owners, investors, utilities and financial institutions to create opportunities for MF solar projects for low-income tenants
 - Engaging with solar investors including Banks with CRA needs, CDFI's and Impact investors, to finance solar projects.
 - Gather market intelligence and expand relationships with local government, utility, and other stakeholder groups to understand the project development and permitting processes
- Develop and create proposals for MFAH owners, investors, utility and other stakeholders.
 - Assistance in development of solar financing model.
- Help close project contracts for MFAH solar projects

Requirements:

- A solid understanding of commercial PV project, PV system design, and solar financing
- Strong fluency in solar project finance, contracts, utility interconnection, and construction/ EPC issues
- 1-3+ years' experience required in renewable energy development
- Project management, organizational, and analytical problem-solving skills
- Flexible and adaptable to change
- Strong organization, communication skills and attention to detail

- Knowledge of solar renewable energy construction process; real estate development; renewable energy projects/assets evaluation and acquisition.
- Knowledge of energy storage systems
